

Flexible Learning Mode MA Factsheet

This factsheet gives more information about studying an MA in the Flexible Learning Mode at Redcliffe College.

Course Structure

You can study all of Redcliffe's five MA programmes via Flexible Learning Mode. This distance-learning style mode allows you to complete a Postgraduate MA in 3-4 years, with a combination of residential study and distance-learning with email support. This can take place in two formats:

Summer School Flexible Learning Mode – all MA programmes:

The first and second years of the course begin with a three-week residential summer school here the taught component of the course takes place. During the rest of the first and second years, students complete the reading and the assignments for each module. The dissertation must normally be submitted within 12 months of completing the second academic year.

Year 1	Begins with summer school in May or June Students study two modules relevant for their course. The first assignment for each module is due at the end of December The second assignment for each module is due at the end of April
Year 2	Begins with summer school in May or June Students study two further modules relevant to the course The first assignment for each module is due at the end of December The second assignment for each module is due at the end of April
Year 3 - 4	Students complete their dissertation

The three week summer school will be held from Monday 30 April – Friday 18 May 2012 (beginning Monday evening)

Weekend Flexible Learning Mode

The taught components of the first and second academic years take place over four long-weekends throughout the year, with assignments completed during the year. The MA programmes on offer for this mode include MA in Global Leadership in Intercultural Contexts – other programmes to be confirmed. Please contact us for more information.

Year 1	The programme begins with the first residential long weekend in early Autumn There are three further residential long weekends throughout the year. Students study two modules and complete the assignments for these modules throughout the year.
Year 2	The course begins with the first residential long weekend in early Autumn There are three further residential long weekends throughout the year Students study two modules and complete the assignments for these modules throughout the year.
Year 3 - 4	Students complete their dissertation

Cost of the course

Fees are charged on an annual basis at the beginning of each of the first two academic years.

In 2011-12, tuition fees are £985 per year, residential fees including meals are £555 per year and the university registration fee is £100 per year. Fees for 2012-13 will be published in due course.

There is a one off dissertation charge of £600 due at the beginning of the first year

You are welcome to stay at the college and use the library facilities for self-study at times other than the residential periods; there is a nominal charge for this.
